

Dermaclinical Chemical Peels

What are Dermaclinical Chemical peels?

Dermaclinical is about the SCIENCE OF SKIN HEALTH.

They have sourced formulae from different labs, each subject matter experts in their own fields: acne, pigmentation and aging. A chemical peel is a procedure in which a chemical solution is applied to the skin to remove the top layers. The skin that grows back is smoother. With a light or medium peel, you may need to undergo the procedure more than once to get the desired results. They can be done alone or combined with other cosmetic procedures. And they can be done at different depths, from light to deep. Deeper chemical peels offer more-dramatic results but also take longer to recover from.

Dermaclinical peel indications:

- Pigmentation
- Scarring
- Enlarged pores
- Fine lines and wrinkles
- Acne

Is it painful?

There is a feeling of heat and tingling. Client tolerance is dependant. A fan will be used to assist with relief.

How soon after filler/botox injections can I have a peel treatment on my face?

You need to wait a minimum of 2 weeks after having the treatment before having a peel treatment to ensure that your results are not compromised.

How long should it take before I see results?

Typically, you will see results after the first treatment. Lasting and more significant results will become visible after 3 to 6 treatments (spaced 4-8 weeks apart). The condition of your skin will continue to improve over the next 6-12 months after a course of treatments, especially when combined with the recommended post-treatment care.

Is there any downtime after treatments?

Generally no, but you may experience facial redness for 12- 48 hours after the treatment. Most people are able to return to normal daily activities immediately after the treatment. Application of the recommended post care treatments will heal the skin for an immediate return to work.

Lactic Acid 10% Peel

- This treatment lifts dull lifeless skin cells, revealing healthy new skin.
- Refines texture and tone for dry, ageing and fragile skin.
- Lactic Acid is potent enough to remove rough skin, but gentle enough to be used on very sensitive skins.
- Helps to minimize pores, softens and brightens skin tone.
- Stimulates the production of GAGs- Ensuring a 'Trellis' work for new collagen production to lay flat.
- Radiant glow.

Gloss Peel

- A concentrated blend of salicylic acid, lactic acid and mandelic acid.
- Reveals clearer, more luminous skin with this triple-exfoliation.
- Removes dead skin clarity and even tone, while helping to rid pores of impurities.
- Soothing herbal extracts keeps the appearance of redness in check.
- Targets the look of dark spots, irregular pigmentation, discoloration and enlarged pores.
- Smooth skin texture and reduces appearance of fine line and wrinkles.

Glycolic Acid Peel (Blend: 50%Glycolic,2%Kojic,1%Lactic,1%Pyruvic)

- Glycolic acid is a chemical exfoliant, and removes all the dead skin cells laying on top of the skin's surface. By doing this, you will reveal healthier skin underneath and a glowing, more youthful complexion will surface. It works to remove cell adhesion.
- Glycolic acid is also effective for removing blackheads, whiteheads, and pimples from skin.
- They also help to reduce pore size.
- Consistent and repeated use of glycolic acid peels have been shown to be effective for removing cystic lesions and acne scars from skin.
- People who have Photodamage,
- People that have Environmental Damage
- Anyone with Hyperpigmentation, Melasma, Elastosis, Blemish-Prone, Dry and Normal Skin Types.

Transbright Ultra Peel

This is a superficial chemical peel combining two non-corrosive acids combined with retinoid to help smooth and brighten the skin.

There is less redness and peeling than our strongest peel (Transbright Max), but can be preformed monthly for 3 months consecutive treatments for optimal results. Best results per peel seen 3 weeks after the in-clinic treatment.

The comprehensive homecare products help to amplify and extend the peel benefits. Ideal for reducing the appearance of fine lines, wrinkles and pigmentation. Downtime 3 days, redness, peeling and dryness.

Transbright Max Peel

This is a new generation chemical peel that challenges the conventional belief that cellular injury is required to effectively modulate epidermal renewal.

Using barrier modification, this peel delivers dramatic results for motivated patient. Can be applied once every 6 months, with on going homecare.

This Retinoid-Medicated superficial flaking 3 days post Transbright peel

This type of peeling is the results of chemically reducing cell 'stickiness'. It is not from a burn, wound or injury that would normally be caused by old-fashioned peeling agents like TCA. Possible down time: Approx 7 Days, redness, peeling, swelling & dryness.

Why is aftercare important?

Homecare for your skin is like going to the dentist (You see your dentist twice a year however you brush your teeth everyday to maintain oral health) The same concept applies to your skin care regime.

Aftercare/Homecare is vital to maintain your results from your in clinic treatment to ensure that we prevent any problematic concerns worsening because "Prevention is always better than cure".

How many sessions will you need?

This will depend on each client and a unique treatment plan will be discussed with you but in general:

- 4 – 6 treatments (or when desired results are achieved)
- 4 week intervals between sessions (treatment area must be completely healed)
- Maintenance treatments are advised after desired results have been achieved

Conditions NOT suitable for Chemical peels:

- Pregnancy/ breastfeeding
- Aneurism
- Herpes Simplex (Fever blisters)
- Hypertension
- Roaccutane/Accutane
- Fibromyalgia
- Acne Vulgaris Stage III-IV
- Epilepsy
- Auto Immune Disorders
- Cancer
