What are Dermapen™ treatments?

Dermapen 4™ is the breakthrough of the decade utilising the most advanced needle cartridge innovation to vertically pierce the skin. Dermapen 4™ glides over the skin creating millions of fine fractional channels up to 104% faster than other microneedling devices. These channels can carry up to 80% more topical nutrients deeper into the skin. In turn our body's natural response triggers a natural process of repair. The result is an increased production of collagen and elastin, resurfacing, retexturising and overall skin renewal anywhere on the body, from hard to reach areas such as around the eyes, eyelids, earlobes, neck, lips, nose or larger areas of neck and décolleté, stomach and legs. Dermapen 4™ is the most technologically advanced microneedling device available. Dermapen 4™ treatments are faster, safe, and produce optimal results.

Dermapen™ indications:

- pigmentation
- scarring
- hairloss
- enlarged pores
- fine lines and wrinkles
- acne
- skin tightening

Is it painful?

Traditional dermal rolling techniques proved to be a bloody and extremely painful treatment. Today with Dermapen 4™ there is no comparison – this is a more comfortable treatment. Dermapen 4™ treatments are more comfortable than any other device but we are able to numb the more sensitive areas such as the eyes, forehead and lip areas.

How soon after filler/botox injections can I have a Dermapen™ treatment?

You need to wait a minimum of 2 weeks after having the treatment before having a Dermapen™ treatment to ensure that your results are not compromised.



How long should it take before I see results?

Typically, you will see results after the first treatment. Lasting and more significant results will become visible after 3 to 6 treatments (spaced 4-8 weeks apart). The condition of your skin will continue to improve over the next 6-12 months after a course of treatments, especially when combined with the recommended post-treatment care.

Is there any downtime after treatments?

Generally no, but you may experience facial redness for 12- 48 hours after the treatment. Most people are able to return to normal daily activities immediately after the treatment. Application of the recommended post care treatments will heal the skin for an immediate return to work.

Preparation before treatments:

- No products with Retinol, AHA's, BHA's or Hydroquinone to be used on the area for 3 days prior to the area to be treated
- No peels, waxing, laser, electrolysis, threading for 2 weeks before the treatment
- No sun exposure for 1 week prior to the treatment

After the treatment:

- You will experience a downtime of 3-5 days – this will depend on client to client (eg. flaking, peeling, dryness, sensitivity and tightness)
- Very important to not exfoliate at home or scratch the skin
- Our Ultra Repair cream is recommended to be applied as much as needed for the next 3-5 days
- Once your peeling/ flaking has subsided, your normal skincare regime can be followed.
- Only cleanse, moisturize and use sunscreen for 3 days post treatment
- Make-up can be applied 24 hours post treatment – Preferable to wait 48 hours before applying make-up
- No peels, waxing, laser, electrolysis, threading for 2 weeks post the treatment
- No sun exposure for 1 week post treatment

Why is aftercare important?

Homecare for your skin is like going to the dentist (You see your dentist twice a year however you brush your teeth everyday to maintain oral health)

The same concept applies to your skin care regime.

Aftercare/Homecare is vital to maintain your results from your in clinic treatment to ensure that we prevent any problematic concerns worsening because "Prevention is always better than cure".

How many sessions will you need?

This will depend on each client and a unique treatment plan will be discussed with you but in general:

- 4 – 6 treatments (or when desired results are achieved)
- 4 week intervals between sessions (treatment area must be completely healed)
- Maintenance treatments are advised after desired results have been achieved

Conditions NOT suitable for Dermapen™:

- Pregnancy/ Breastfeeding
- Anyone on Roaccutane/Accutane
- Papulopustular Rosacea
- Herpes Simplex
- Open Lesions
- Scleroderma
- Skin Cancer
- Acne Vulgaris stage III-IV
- Warts
- Bacterial/Fungal Infections
- Solar Keratosis
- Haemophilia
